The Art Guild at Fairfield Glade is a non-profit art organization (FID#20-1436572) whose mission is to "Teach, Learn, and Inspire" through classes, workshops, art exhibits and shows, gallery tours, and community outreach. The Art Guild's Plateau Creative Arts Center includes a state-of-the-art studio and an art gallery with monthly exhibits featuring original art by local area artists. In addition to the galleries' exhibit and sale of artwork, jewelry, and pottery, in the studio we offer many types of art classes to members and guests. Our art classes cover all visual arts (water and oil mediums, fiber, and glass). We also offer a "Smorgasbord of Art" series of classes in jewelry, photography, and mixed media, to name a few. We encourage new types of art and artists to share their skills and techniques by instructing others. In 2020 we opened "Endless Possibilities" – a fine arts and crafts shop – at the art center. Our new shop sells many different items, all made by our member artists.

Our **Children Outreach** programs supports Cumberland County area home-school children and offers free classes in the summer. Our funding for the children's programs is funded mainly by our Annual Golf Fundraiser, schedule on July 15th in 2022. In addition to donating art supplies to our schools, and for the in-house instruction, **we provide \$1000 scholarship to a deserving high school senior** who will continue studies in visual arts. We are also a proud participant in the STARTS (Support for the Arts) program supporting Music and Visual Arts in Crossville.

Our Community Outreach activities for adults are very well-attended. On June 11th -12th, we are hosting our annual "Art in the Park" an outdoor event that includes local art vendors, music, and many surprises for those attending. Our "Fun and Wine Friday" events, held on the first Friday of each month, are wonderful opportunities for people to enjoy the new gallery exhibit and fellowship with members and guests. This event is open to the public at no cost. We have a beautiful Sculpture Trail around our building. All guests are invited to stroll the trail and enjoy the many sculptures created by some incredibly talented artists.
